I afterwards saw some of the Indians, who suggested to me that the Department should be willing to buy them a piece of land in view of their notion that the Government had allowed their native land to be sold to white men over their heads, to which I made answer that I would lay the matter before the Department for its consideration.


I may say that the piece of land referred to as being possible to buy is really the only convenient and suitable ground for the purpose for a distance of five miles, at which distance is a piece of land having an area of 28 acres for sale at the price of \$100.00 per acre.

I shall thank  kindly let me know if the Department is prepared to purchase a piece of land as required for these Indians.
