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A. S/Sgt Chester was not satisfied and told me to arrest the accused. I did and took him to #6 Coy C.P.C. H.Q. and handed him over to H.C.O. 1/c cells

Cross examined by Defence

Q. You mention when you questioned the accused on day and time of arrest he said he was a Canadian Soldier and produced a pass. Did he actually show you the pass?

A. Yes, he took out pay book and said
"Here is my pass and pay book."

2nd Witness for Prosecution

B. 76047 A/Sgt Cheater H. W. of special
Investigation Section C.P.C.
being duly sworn, is examined by Prosecutor

Q. Do you recognize the accused.

A. yes Sir. This is the Foucher

Q. Can you recall any incident involving accused

A. Yes Sir. When on duty in Tokyo district
London on 14 Aug 42 at approx 1515 hrs
accused was checked by H/cpl Fox and
myself for identification. He was in
civilian clothes. The accused said he was
in the army and produced pay book & pass
(Witness identified Lt. "A" as pass produced).
The pass appeared to be false. I asked him
if this was not so. Accused admitted the
pass was false & that he was absent without
leave. I instructed H/cpl Fox to place him under arrest.

*Cross Examined
by Defense*

Q. When accused was asked for papers did he actually produce pay book and show pass or did you find pass in pay book.

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A. He took pass and handled pass and paybook separately.
