Dear Sir:-

Enclosed herewith please find Scale Bills Nos. 49200, 49203, 49204, 49205, 49211 and 49221, representing 1, 313, 549 feet of timber cut from Toguanna Reserve No. 4 of the Giammon Band. This is from one of the permits issued by Mr. Timber Supervisor Bury some years ago, originally given to Messrs. Peers & Anderson. If my memory serves me correctly, Peers & Anderson transferred the permit to Plummer & Company, and I suppose the Palmer Owen Logging Company are cutting either for Plummer & Company or Peers & Anderson.

As this represents a large amount of money, I think it advisable that you should take immediate action to see that these booms are paid for at once.
