To His Excellency SIR EDMUND WALKER HEAD, Baronet, Governor General of *British North America*, and Captain General and Governor-in-Chief in and over the Provinces of *Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick*, and the Island of *Prince Edward*, and Vice Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY :—

We, Her Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Legislative Council of *Canada*, in Provincial Parliament assembled, respectfully thank Your Excellency for your gracious Speech from the Throne at the opening of the present Session.

We assure Your Excellency that you are warranted in the belief in which you have been pleased to inform us, that the time of year having arrived when the Country again requires our services, you have called Parliament together; and that Your Excellency may rely upon every effort being made by this House to promote the good government and increase the prosperity of *Canada*.

We beg leave to express to Your Excellency our thankfulness that, by the blessing of Providence, that prosperity has met with no check, and to thank Your Excellency for the assurance that the restoration of peace to Europe, and the hope that good-will and friendly feeling will continue to prevail on this Continent, inspire you with confidence in the future.
