

The specific gravity of these submarine is not much less than the water itself from their sides which enables them by their motive power to dive below the surface in the 'teens of seconds, and get out of the danger zone of either gunfire or ramming in a few moments This type of submarine will be far more difficult to destroy than the older type. But submarines are largely unassailable by one another, and so far we have not heard of one submarine destroying another.
