LOCAL MARKETS

Saturday, July 20, 1904.
The market today was well attended by the farmers and gardeners. The majority of the stuff on sale consisted of the smaller lines, such as small fruits and garden truck. Sales were very slow in the early part of the market. Later on in the day, however, trade picked up a little. On the whole, the market was not as largely attended as on the previous Saturday. Prices were inclined to be easier for most of the lines reported on the market.

Grains—Oats were the only kind of grain offered. About fifteen loads were on sale, prices ranging at \$1.00 to \$1.07 per cwt., mostly at \$1.05 per cwt. Several loads of hay were brought in, they being bargained for on Friday. Prices were \$5 and \$5.50 per ton. Butter and Eggs—Butter was in good demand, there being more inquiries than for several weeks past. Sales were made at higher prices. Butter in crocks went at 16c to 17c per pound; for choice pound rolls 17c to 18c was paid, for the basket lots. Eggs were a shade easier at 16c per dozen for most of the lots offered. A few sold at 17c per dozen. Poultry—Red raspberries were lower in price, at 3c to 3.50 per quart. Black raspberries, 3c to 3.50 per quart. Gooseberries, 6c to 8c per quart. Black currants were scarce at 10c per quart. Apples were plentiful and dull of sale at 15c per peck. Vegetables and Roots—This line was the feature of the market, nearly every vehicle having its quota of vegetables. New potatoes were a slow sale, and onions were easier. Peas were in good demand at 10c to 12c per quart. Cabbages were plentiful at 8c to 10c per dozen. Corn, 15c per bushel. Tomatoes were lower at 9c for the 18-lb basket. Cauliflowers, \$1 to \$1.50 per dozen. Other vegetables were plentiful at prices quoted.

Poultry—There was a fairly large supply and the following prices ruled: Spring chickens, 50c to 75c per pair; live, 50c to 55c per pair; old hens, 60c to 80c per pair; ducks, dressed, 70c to 80c per pair. Live Hogs—Mr. D. McIntyre, local buyer, intends to make a shipment on Monday, and will pay \$5.10 to \$5.15 per cwt. Onions a number of small sized ones at \$4.50 to \$5 per bushel. Pig's Feet—Not many offered at \$7.50 to \$8 per pair. Sales were about as quoted.

JUDGE WOULD NOT MAKE A CHANGE FROM THE HOUSE

The Assessment of Westminster Township Upheld at \$51 Per Acre.

Judge Macbeth this morning handed down his judgment in the appeal of Westminster Township against the equalization of the assessment made by the county council at its last session. By the finding the equalization remains unchanged.

Four townships intended to appeal, namely Westminster, Delaware, London and Lobo, but the last three failed to serve notice of appeal on the county clerk, and their evidence was not taken. By the finding the equalization remains unchanged.

The quarantine was maintained till Thursday night, when the guards were removed, the house thorowly fumigated, and the placard taken down, the family being thus given a clean bill of health.
