### BORDEN EVIDENCE ALL IN

THE COUNSEL WILL ADDRESS THE  
JURY ON MONDAY.

The "You Gave Me Away" Story Continued—Emma Borden, a Government witness, testified strongly in New Bedford, Mass., June 16.—There was less of a crowd at the court house this morning at the resumption of the Borden trial than there has been at any time since the beginning of the trial, although the air is delightfully cool and it is a fine day. The jury returned at 11 o'clock and the trial resumed. Among the early visitors was Miss Emma Borden, who is understood to be called by the defense, although she was sworn as a Government witness.

No Hurdles to Searchers.  
Mrs. Holmes testified that the doors were not hindered in entering defendant's room and thoroughly searching the house. Defendant went when looking for his father's remains on the day of the funeral. TO HIS WORSHIP THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TORONTO:

WHEREAS at a meeting of the City Council held Jan. 19, 1891, it was moved by Ald. Leslie, seconded by Ald. Lindsay, That if at any time during the lease of the streets of this city for street railway purposes, as per tenders to be received on Feb. 2 next, a petition be presented to this council, signed by 500 ratemayers qualified to vote for members of this council, asking that the question of street cars on Sunday be submitted to the ratemayers, the said question shall be submitted in due course;

WHEREAS Section 40 of the Agreement between the City Council and the Kiley-Everett Syndicate stipulates: No car shall run on the Lord's Day until a Sunday Service has been approved by the citizens by a vote taken on the question;
