BROOKE COUNCIL

Inwood, June 18th, 1921
Council met pursuant to adjournment. Members all present. Minutes of former meeting read and on motion of Loosemore—Sutton were adopted.

Messrs. J. H. Johnston and B. A. McIntyre interviewed the Council asking for a grant in aid of the Brooke and Alvinston Agricultural Society.

Loosemore—Sutton, that \$100 be granted.—Carried.

Mr. A. E. Loosemore, commissioner in charge of the repairs being done to the drain opposite Lots 7, 8, con. 7, reported the work completed at a cost of \$386.17.

Loosemore—McLean, that report be adopted and the amount be pro rata over lands and roads assessed for the last repair as per agreement of petitioners and assessed on 1921 Collectors Roll for collection.—Car.

Sutton—Loosemore, that Mc-Kinlay be paid \$10.00 for one lamb killed and one sheep worried by dogs.—Carried.

Petition received signed by a majority in number asking that the area comprising lots 18 and w 1/2 19 in the 12th con. and s pt 18 and w 1/2 19, con. 13, and the 12th and 13th con. road opposite lots 18-19 be drained by means of a drain or drains.

Sutton—Loosemore, that petition

be entertained and A. S. Code, O. L.S., C.E., be instructed to make an examination of the area, lay out the drain submit report, plan, profile, estimate and to make an assessment of lands and roads liable under the Municipal Drainage Act.—Carried.

Brooke Municipal Telephone System asked that \$200 be advanced for Telephone purposes.—Granted.

Statement of the payments made by the Township of Enniskillen on the Graham-Bourne drain was received from Clerk showing Brooke's share of the overpayment to be \$126.76.

Sutton—Campbell, that payments made by Enniskillen Township on this drain previous to 1914 be not acknowledged and Brooke's share of the balance amounting to \$86.14 be pro rata over lands and roads assessed in by-law No. 19 of 1915 and entered on 1921 Collector's Roll for collection.—Carried.

Sutton—Lindsay, that Council do now adjourn to meet in Alvinston on Saturday, the 16th day of July, 1921.—Carried.
