The said Pharmaceutical Society shall have Pharmacenpower to acquire and hold real estate, not exceeding at tical Soci any time, in annual value, \$5;000; and the same, or any real estate. part thereof, may alienate, exchange, mortgage, lease, or otherwise change, or dispose of, as occasion may require: and may erect buildings for the purpose of accommodating Lecturers on Chemistry, or Pharmacy, or for a Library, Pharmaceutical Museum, or Specimen Room for the use of the Members and Associates of the said Society; and all fees payable under this Act shall belong to the said Society for the purposes of this Act.
