COMMERCIAL ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY

Maine has the smallest electronics industry in New England.

Of all the companies producing electronics and related products, the largest are Shape Ind. (video/audio cassettes), National Semiconductor (employees 1500 and manufactures digital semiconductors), and Vishay Sprague (electronic component including capacitors).

One major change in the industry was the sale of operations at Waldoboro and Bangor, Maine by GTE to Osram/Sylvania. Another division of GTE in Standish was purchased by an investment group and now operates as Control Devices Inc.
