

From now on, Physics and Chemistry will be necessary in Grades X and XI. After 1928 Physical Geography will not be accepted by McGill University as a matriculation subject. It will be necessary to provide for the teaching of Physics this year.

Advanced Mathematics ought to be taught when desired. It is necessary for Science Matriculation, and many of our pupils go to other schools because it is not taught here.

In conclusion, I give figures taken from the official records at Quebec, to show the present size of our school. There are 51 High Schools in the province. Outside of Westmount(1) and of Montreal which has 5, there are 45. Of these schools Macdonald is fifth in size.

It will be noticed that these are all suburban high schools. If Macdonald is classes as a country high school, it is the largest of its class in the province.
