BILL C.

An Act respecting the Capital Stock of The Ottawa Electric Railway Company.

Preamble.

WHEREAS The Ottawa Electric Railway Company, a body corporate declared by section seven of chapter eighty-six of the statutes of 1894, to be subject to the legislative authority of the Parliament of Canada, has by its petition prayed that it may be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Section four of chapter eighty-six of the statutes of 1894, is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—

“4. The capital stock of the Company shall consist of forty thousand shares without nominal or par value.”
