A By-law to regulate the proceedings in the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto and the Committees thereof.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the By-law now in force, to regulate the proceedings in Municipal Council, and in Committees of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto:

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, enacts as follows:

MEETINGS AND ADJOURNMENTS OF COUNCIL.

1. That in all the proceedings had or taken in the Muni- This By-law to cipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, the ings in Council. following rules and regulations shall be observed and shall be the rules and regulations for the order and despatch of business in the said Council, and of the Committees of the said Council, and from and after the passing of this By-law No. 378, and all former By-law, By-law number three hundred and seventy-rules repealed. eight, and all former rules and regulations shall be repealed.

That the said Conneil shall meet every Monday in the Meetings of the year, at the hour of seven o'clock, unless otherwise ordered by special motion, or unless such Monday shall be a public holiday, according to law, when the Council shall meet at the same hour on the next following day, which shall not be such public holiday.
