A By-law to regulate the proceedings in the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto and the Committees thereof.

PASSED 26TH NOVEMBER, 1869.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the By-law now in force, to regulate the proceedings in Municipal Council, and in Committees of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto:

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, enacts as follows:

MEETINGS AND ADJOURNMENTS OF COUNCIL.

1. That in all the proceedings had or taken in the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, the following rules and regulations shall be observed and shall be the rules and regulations for the order and despatch of business in the said Council, and of the Committees of the said Council, and from and after the passing of this By-law, By-law number three hundred and seventy-eight, and all former rules and regulations shall be repealed. This By-law to govern proceedings in Council.
By-law No. 273, and all former rules repealed.
2. That the said Council shall meet every Monday in the year, at the hour of seven o'clock, unless otherwise ordered by special motion, or unless such Monday shall be a public holiday, according to law, when the Council shall meet at the same hour on the next following day, which shall not be such public holiday. Meetings of the Council.
3. That unless there shall be a quorum present in half an hour after the time appointed for the meeting of Council, the Council shall then stand absolutely adjourned until the next day of meeting, and the Clerk shall, if required by two members, take down the names of the members present If there is no quorum in half an hour after the time appointed for a meeting, the Council shall stand adjourned till the next day of meeting.
