Velvet Sale Denied—The Athabasca Property—Re-Opening the Empress Mine.

RE LAKE OF THE WOODS MINING

General Mining News—What is Being Done on the Mining Exchanges.

We have to hand a copy of The British Columbia Review, a prosperous-looking mining journal, devoted to the interests of Klondike, Cariboo, Klondike and Ontario, and published at 65 New Broad-street, London, Eng. The Review quotes the prices of Canadian mining stocks in London, and also gives in full the quotations on the Toronto Exchange. Regarding the state of the London market on May 8, the date of issue, it remarks: "The chief movement has centred in Le Bois, which has fluctuated somewhat, at one time selling at 1/2, but they finish to-day at 9/8. S.A.C.'s, after touching 20s, are lost. Hill mines are better on receipt of the smelting returns. Ymirs are firm, and are generally expected to go to 22. Directly the news of the last crushing is received, Velvets, Athabasca, and White-waters are favorably affected in the quarters. Queen Bee appears likely to go much higher. The prospects of the Foley mine, in Western Ontario, will be submitted to the public before very long. The Granite has been re-opened with \$200,000 capital. The latest reports from this free-milling property are exceedingly satisfactory. We hear from Toronto that the Centre Star will be offered over here in the autumn. The Review publishes articles on many of the Canadian camps. It also contains the following: "There is no truth whatever in the statement that the New Goldfields of B.C. have repurchased the Velvet for \$100,000 cash."

Progress in Rosland Camp.

Progress in Rosland Camp. Record-breaking plant on the Le Bois mine, for the purpose of containing development on the 600-foot level, the British Columbia Corporation is fast pushing work on its other properties. Manager Carlyle recently had a machine set up on the Rosland station on the "No. 1." The shaft, which is already down 325 feet, is at the same time being pushed to the 200-foot level. The Rosland Miner says that the "No. 1" will be a shipper before the fall.

Opening Up the Old Empress.

The world's correspondent at Jackfish, on the north shore of Lake Superior, sends some particulars of the re-opening of the Empress mine by Mr. James B. Beebe. Mr. Beebe found the mine in good shape when he went there. Some prospecting pits had been sunk on the surface and a tunnel had been driven to the level of the hill for some 400 feet. The property is found amply equipped with a Fraser & Chalmers steam engine and a large air compressor. He immediately set 20 men to work and is now conservatively proceeding with development work. His men are working night and day, and he is proceeding with a view to blocking out enough ore to start the mill up. He has sunk an 8 x 6-foot shaft in drift No. 1 from the main tunnel, which is driven 200 feet to the mouth of the tunnel. He is down 25 feet in this shaft and intends to drift both ways when the 200-foot shaft is reached, which will be about June 1.

Lake of Woods Navigation.

Navigation in the Lake of the Woods district will be greatly facilitated this year by the action of the Dominion Government in setting aside \$75,000 for the construction of a dam and locks at Long Sault Rapids, on the Rainy River. The broken craters, weighing 1200 pounds, has arrived at Rat Portage and will go up to Fort Frances by the steamer Kenora and will thence be shipped across Italy Lake to the mill.

Mines Near Rat Portage.
