BY-LAWS, REGULATIONS, ETC.

I.—OF THE CONSTITUTION.

- I. The Association shall be called the Ontario Branch of the Royal Caledonian Curling Club.
- 2. Its object shall be to promote the Game of Curling in Canada, and mainly in the Province of Ontario; to unite all the curling clubs in the Province in one organization; to hold fraternal intercourse with other neighbouring curling associations; and to maintain connection with the Royal Caledonian Curling Club, as a corresponding association.
- 3. Its membership shall consist of the members, regular and occasional, of all curling clubs which may be received into the Association, and conform to the rules thereof, as adopted.
- 4. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Representative Committee, composed of one representative appointed by each affiliated club, as hereinafter provided, which shall have power to elect the office-bearers of the Association, and to appoint committees for the transaction of the business thereof.
- 5. An Annual General Meeting of the members of the Association shall be held in Toronto, on the Second Tuesday in April of each year, to receive the Annual Report of the Representative Committee, and take action
