

## Aid 17,172 Children Mistreated In Year

Society for Prevention of Cruelty Reports Alarming Gain in Crimes.

The review of the work of the New York Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children for the year ended Dec. 31, 1922, presents a record of 17,-172 cases involving the protection of children under 16 years of age and shows a slight increase in the number of children received for shelter over the year before. The report is issued on the eve of the fiftieth anniversary of the birth of the organization and contains a brief survey of the society's history.




