How to cure a bearing horse. I will give you a plan that has succeeded well with all of the worst cases I ever saw.

A good disinfectant. One pound of green copper, dissolved in one quart of water and poured down a water-closet, will effectually concentrate and destroy the foul smell.

To keep tomatoes for winter use. As the tomato season is now here, I contribute one way of keeping them for winter use that may be new to some of your readers.

To prevent a bone fever. When you find that you have a bone fever coming, apply a fly blister to the affected part immediately, and let it draw to its fullest extent.

Tomato sauce. To one gallon of stewed and strained tomatoes, add six tablespoonfuls of fine salt, two of pepper, four of allspice, two of cloves, and one of nutmeg, all powdered.

Parasae. Here is a grand panacea for swelling or weariness of the feet. It is as effective as is the simplest.

Herbs intended for drying should be picked just before the plants blossom. Wash them until they are entirely free from dust, and place them on a sieve to drain.
