Translation

François Saillebont, aged 46 years, duly sworn, declares and says:-I know the parties in this case. Never the land in dispute. worked on the land in dispute with the late lierre doontour 22 years ago breaking up the land. The first time Iwent there, Iwent to cut underbrush. Sworked on this land for the late Grantour every spring for five consultins years, and at other timesin the artum. Iwas there at ather times to land him a hand, but I was not engaged. Souse saw the lote Osias beloche cutting wood on this land, and there Scontour sent him there; and Quelocke cut on his land below the hill; be cut five perches. Quontour did not buy this land: be took possession get in order to work it in accordance with the custom at the time. I do not know whether the man called the oldlyey Horse had my land there: Sneder heard him say so. Heland
