Score of Prisoners Trapped in
Jail in Basement Rescued by
Firemen and Police.

Brownsville, Penna., May 2.—An explosion, believed to have been caused by a bomb placed in the office of Charles H. Storey, wrecked the municipal buildings and shattered windows for several blocks in the business district here early today. The damage is estimated at many thousands of dollars. A score of prisoners, trapped in the jall in the basement of the building, a three story brick structure, which collapsed over them, were rescued by fremen. Policemen and agents of the Department of Justice said they believed the explosion was an anarchist May Day plot.
