

last year 3,385 in-patients were admitted, and 10,929 of out-patients received treatment in the out-door department. Particular arrangements have been made for the benefit of the students of the Woman's Medical College. Special seats in the operating theatre, with a separate entrance, are set apart for their use. Practical instructions at the bedside will be given in the hospital wards by Dr. Nevitt and Dr. Macdonald. These classes are exclusively for students of the Woman's Medical College. A limited number of Clinical Clerkships may be obtained by students of the final year on application to the above-named gentlemen. Every opportunity will be afforded for the most careful study of disease in all its forms. *Post mortems*, to which women alone will be admitted, are held, of which due notice is given. The regular Clinical Lectures given daily in the large theatre by the various professors are open to the women students.

The out-patients Clinics take place daily at 1.30 o'clock. Students of the Woman's Medical College will receive special attention on Mondays from Dr. McMahon.

Dr. Jas. F. W. Ross will give a weekly Clinic in Gynaecology to the final students, at which every opportunity will be given for personal examination of the patients.

The Victoria Hospital for Sick Children.

This large and commodious hospital, with 160 beds, is situated on College St., in direct street-car communication with the College. This is the only hospital wholly devoted to diseases of children in Canada, and with its most approved modern appliances, and the excellent Intern, Extern, and Dispensing Departments, affords unrivalled advantages to the students of the Woman's Medical College.

Clinics in Diseases of Children will be delivered in this hospital twice a week by Drs. Nevitt, Macallum, Thistle, McKenzie and Machell.
