TILLEY, *Hon. Samuel Leonard, C. B.* [*St. John City, N. B.*] L.

B. in Queen's County, N. B. B. 8 May, 1818. Ed. at County Grammar School. M. in 1867, Miss Chipman, of St. Stephens, N. B. Created C. B. [Civil] 1867. Was a mem. of the Ex. Council, N. B. and Provincial Secretary from 1854 to 1856, again in the same office from 1857 to 1865, when as head of the Government he and his colleagues resigned; and again from the early part of 1866 until the Union. Appointed a mem. of the Privy Council and Minister of Customs, 1 July, 1867. Sat in House of Assembly, N. B., from 1850 to 1856, when he was defeated, and from 1857 until 1866, when he was again defeated. Returned again in April, 1866, and continued to sit until the Union. Pop. 27,317.—*St. John; Ottawa.*
