

ARTICLE IX.

RULES OF ORDER.

SECTION 1.

When a Member wishes to speak on any subject, he shall rise and address the Chairman, and no Member shall be permitted to speak more than twice on the same motion, (except in explanation, by special permission of the Chairman.)

The President shall open all business meetings of the Company, by calling the Members to order and desiring the Color Sergeant to call the Roll.

The order of business shall be as follows:—

- 1.—Minutes of Preceding Meetings.
- 2.—Liquidation of Accounts.
- 3.—Reports of the Board.
- 4.—Motions pursuant to notice.
- 5.—New Business.
- 6.—Adjournment.

SECTION 2.

All motions shall be in writing, when requested by the Chairman, accompanied by the names of the mover and seconder, and no discussion shall be permitted thereon, until the Chairman shall have formally read and declared the motion to be before the meeting. In case of an amendment or amendments, the vote shall be first taken upon the last offered, and if lost, retrogressively towards the main motion.

SECTION 3.

When two Members shall rise to address the Chair, the Chairman shall name the first speaker.
