Canoeists Venture down Moon River

Eight Venturers from the 1st Clarkson Company made a four-day canoe trip down the Moon River last week.

Starting at the bridge on highway 103 12 miles north of Port Severn, Venturers Tim Ramsey, Kevin Cole man, Kim Maxfield, Bob Firth, Ian Parrish, Colin Pearson, Mike Hamilton and Jim Hellstrom paddled and portaged their canoes along the Moon River to

Moon Falls and back.

Although the total journey was less than 20 miles, more than two dozen river obstacles were encountered which required the canoes to be either portaged or man-handled in some fashion through rapids or rocky obstructions.

The most difficult section of the river was at the Seven Sisters rapids! In a half mile stretch. seven rapids came one after the other in quick succession, which taxed the skill of the Venturers in finding the best meth-od of paddling, lining or

carrying the canoes past the hazards.

The party was led by Venturer advisor Gord Maxfield and assisted by 'Patch' Laffiere of Scar-boro. 'Patch' has been adopted by the company and this is his second canoe trip with the Venturers. Born in Kiosk in the northern part of Algonquin Park, it is natural for 'Patch' to be an experienced canoeist. bush traveller and keen fisherman.

On reaching Moon Falls, camp was set up on a rocky bluff providing a spectacular view of the falls and the open river flowing out to Georgian Bay.

The Venturer company is part of the 1st Clarkson Scout Group and was formed three years ago by Venturer advisor Maxfield. Venturers are made up of boys from 14 to 17 years old and carry out activities at or near the adult level with a minimum of adult supervis-
