Area under S.S.A. - 71 acres

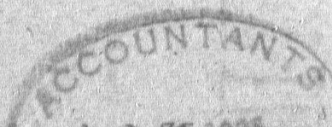
Crops

- Fall wheat - 16 acres
- Corn - 11 acres
- Potatoes and other hoe crop - 4 acres
- Oats - 13 acres on rented land

Stock and Equipment

- 3 cows
- 1 yearling heifer
- 1 yearling bull
- drill
- disc harrow
- drag harrow
- wagon
- rake
- mower
- binder
- plow

This settler claims to have had 35 acres fall ploughed. He has constructed about 300 rods of fence since the place was purchased. There are no buildings on the place and I found him working on the main land for a white man and claims he is receiving \$50 per month for him services. He was strongly advised by me to keep a careful watch on his own place to finish the construction of a fence and to build a stable with lumber that the Department gave him permission to cut. He promises to make his payment but I am just a little doubtful of our prospects of receiving it.
