Referring to your letter of the 18th Instant, regarding return of the sum of \$10.40 in favour of the Indian Locatee of the land leased, Joseph Delisle, I would say that it would appear that this money should be returned in favour of the Lessee, if, as stated, he paid for the repairs made to the buildings, and I would suggest that you obtain another account in detail- which should not be an impossibility- and forward same to the Department, upon receipt of which the same will be given due consideration.
