KNOW all men by these presents
that We the principal Village and War
chiefs of the Ottawa, Chippawa, Pottawatam,
and Huron Indians of Detroit for and in
consideration of the sum of twelve hundred
Pounds currency of the Province of Quebec
at five shillings per Spanish dollar for our
liable war and Merchandize to us deliver-
ed by the hands of Alexander McNeely Esq.
Deputy Agent of Indian Affairs the receipt
whereof We do hereby acknowledge, have by
and with the consent of the whole of our
said nations, given, granted, conveyed, alien-
ated and confirmed, and by these presents do
give, grant, convey, alien and confirm unto
His Majesty George the Third King of Great
Britain, France and Ireland Defender of the
Faith &c. &c. a certain Tract of Land begin-
ning at the mouth of Catfish Creek com-
monly called River au Chaudiere on the
North side of Lake Erie, being the Western
extremity of a tract purchased by his said
Majesty from the Huron Indians
in the year one thousand seven hundred
and eighty four and from thence running
Westward along the border of Lake Erie
and up the Straite to the mouth of a River
known by the name of Channail Carté and
up the main branch of the said Channail
Carté
