Genesis 1 : 27.

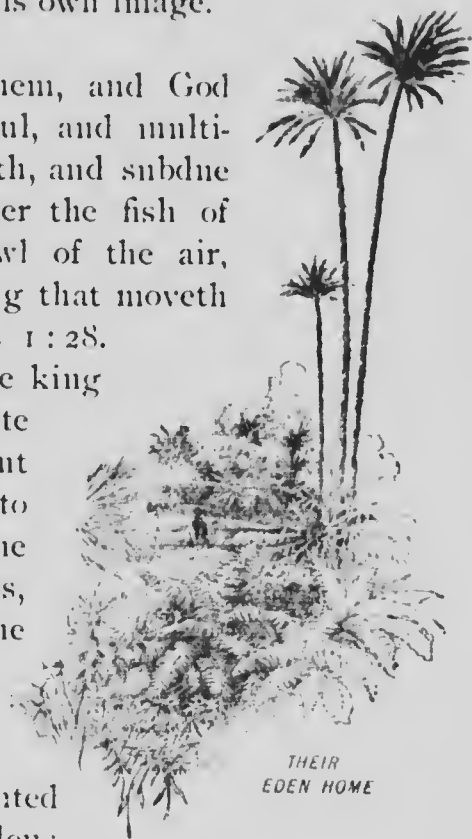
