An Act for creding Court Houses, with proper Offices in the several Districts of Quebec and Montreal, and for defraying the expences thereof.

[3d June, 1799.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN.

Preambie.

THEREAS it hath pleased Your Majesty, by Message to both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, to fignify that Your Majesty, in your paternal regard for the welfare and happiness of your faithful subjects in this Province, hath been graciously pleased to give your Royal attention to the representations which have been made relative to the erection of proper Buildings, for holding the Courts of Juffice in the several Districts of Quebec and Montreal, and to authorise the Governor of this Province, to advance on the part of Your Majefty, the Sums which shall be requisite for that purpole, to be replaced at fuch time and in fuch manner as, in the wildom of the Provincial Parliament may be found expedient. And whereas, Court Houles or Halls, with proper Offices, for the convenient fittings of the Courts of Juffice in the several Districts of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, are of urgent necessary, and for the honour of Your Majesty's Government and the dignity of Justice ought to be forthwith erccled. May it therefore pleate Your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majelly, by and with the advice and constent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflituted and allembled by virtue of and under the authority of An Act, passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled. "An Att to repeal certain parts of an Att passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Att for making more effectual provision for the Covernment of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall and may be lawful to and for His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of this Province for the time being, by an Instrument under his hand and feal at Arms, to appoint in each of the faid Districts of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, three persons to be Commissioners for erecting the Court Houses and proper *Offices for the convenient fittings of the Courts of Justice, to-be erected in pursuance of this Act in each of the faid Districts respectively, to remove, from time to time, the them and appoint said Commissioners or any of them, and to appoint others in the place and stead of fuch as shall be removed, or shall die or resign their trust.

The Governor to appoint three commilli ners in each of the diftricts of Quebec and Montreal, to rbuilding of the Court Houses and proper Offices.

To remove them or any of others in their Strad.

The Commillioners to fix on a Lot of Ground in each of the Cities of Quenec the excition of the . Court , Houses sad Offices.

Provided that before the Lots of Ground are fisolly fixed on &c. the fame to be approved of by the Governor.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that in each of the faid Districts of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, the said Commissioners for such Districts respectively, or any two of them, as soon as may be, after their respective appointments, shall fix upon some convenient Lot of Ground in each of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, whercon such Court Houses and proper Offices aforefaid may be conveniently erected; Provided always, that the dituation and other circumstances relative to such Lots of Ground, and to each of them, shall by the said Commissioners or any two of them in each of the said Districts, respectively, be reported to and be approved, by His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Perfon-
