

Parcels for Military Forces Overseas

(1) Parcels must not exceed in weight.
(2) Parcels addressed to the Newfoundland Forces should bear the name and address of a second address to whom the parcels may be forwarded if it becomes impossible to deliver to the original address. This should be written on the FRONT of the parcel where the postage and Customs declaration are placed and the second or alternate address should be written on the BACK of the parcel.
(3) If a second address is furnished at the time of posting delivery cannot be guaranteed. The contents of the parcel, if exceptional value or character, will be turned over to Military Authorities for retention.
(4) Parcels containing articles of personal nature or of great value will be returned on request for their return. If non-delivery is made, a request, such request to be written on the cover of the parcel at the time of posting.
(5) This plan is being adopted in the office, which states that the present procedure of holding parcels at the Post Office until instructions are received as to their disposal, resulting in the wastage of a quantity of perishable goods which form the contents of parcels addressed to military forces.
