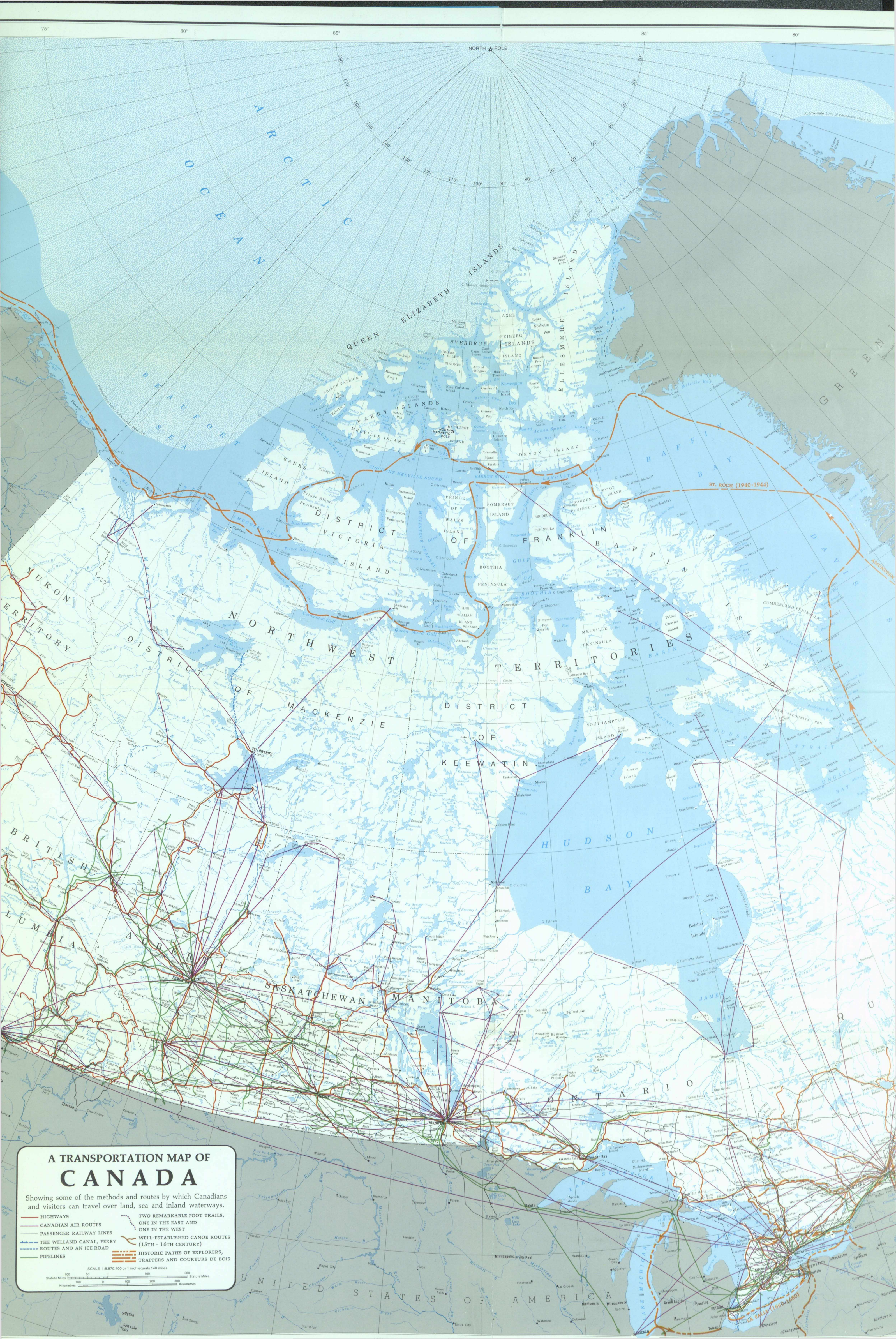




# A TRANSPORTATION MAP OF CANADA
