

- economic and scientific exchanges concerning urban and regional development,
- continuous negotiations on fisheries and maritime boundary delimitation (Canada/St. Pierre and Miquelon),
- conclusion or negotiation of various legal agreements (social security, transfer of prisoners, extradition, customs fraud etc.).

Overall, Franco-Canadian relations include the full range of inter-state diplomatic contacts with a unique feature - it allows for deep friendship (between the two nations) and the existence of special bonds between Canada and Quebec in areas of provincial jurisdiction. Added to this is the contribution that French settlers made to the evolution and development of Canada.
