

Wednesday, Oct. 7

11:25 a.m. Approx. The Queen and The Duke leave the *Britannia* for slow drive to Province House (Legislative Buildings) and its Confederation Chamber where golden book is signed, and balcony appearance is made. On arrival at this Building, Her Majesty and His Royal Highness pass through two rows of war amputees.

(Normal photographic coverage for arrival; fixed positions behind semi-circular railing for signing of golden book; possible pool shots of brief appearance on balcony with Premier and Mrs. Shaw and Solicitor-General and Mrs. MacNaught.)

11:40 a.m. The Royal Couple depart by slow drive for Children's Rally at Exhibition Grounds, arriving at 12:00. After arrival at dais, children in stands opposite sing "God Save The Queen" and programme, including presentations to selected children, proceeds.

(Normal coverage with fixed positions announced at previous briefings.)

12:10 p.m. Royal Couple leave Exhibition Grounds and drive to Government House for luncheon given by Lieut. Governor and Mrs. MacDonald.

(Arrival and departure coverage only.)

2:30 p.m. The Queen and Duke of Edinburgh return to the Royal Yacht.

5:30 - 6:30 p.m. Reception aboard the Royal Yacht largely for federal and provincial officials.

8:10 p.m. The Royal Couple drive to Charlottetown Hotel for State Dinner.
