HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA

BILL 148.

An Act to amend the Quebec Savings Banks Act.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

charters
continued.

1. The charters of the Montreal City and District Savings Bank and of La Caisse d'Economie de Notre Dame de Quebec, which expire on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four by virtue of the operation of section four of the *Quebec Savings Banks Act*, chapter fourteen of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, and chapter twenty-eight of the statutes of 1932-33, and section one of chapter thirty-nine of the statutes of 1934, are hereby continued and shall remain in force until the first day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, except in so far as they, or either of them, are or become forfeited or void under the terms thereof, or of the *Quebec Savings Banks Act*, or of any other Act heretofore or hereafter passed relating to the said savings banks by non-performance of the conditions of such charters or Acts respectively, or by insolvency, or otherwise.
