men grumbled and went out of the room. They said, "This is your strike and we will do as you say, but when the next trouble comes we will take the lead."

In closing, Mr. Speaker, I want to say that I have not brought in this bill with the view of making it any easier for anyone to urge the use of force in this country. I will join with anyone in denouncing the use of force or the advocacy of force, but I do plead for the removal of this legislation, which is objected to by important sections of our community, and which readily lends itself to abuse.
