## BUTTER IMPORTS

## Question No. 4,984—Mr. Lambert (Bellechasse):

For the year 1975, by month, how many pounds of butter were imported (a) from what countries (b) at what cost?

Mr. Marcel Roy (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce): Statistics Canada reports the following: Imports of butter into Canada in the period January to December 1975 amounted to 10,063,900 pounds for a value of \$5,897,000. The Canadian consumption of butter during 1975 was 11.53 pounds per capita, or 263,266,000 pounds in total. The amount imported into Canada during 1975 was 3.82 per cent of the total amount consumed. The following table shows the amount imported by month from each country of consignment and the average price in cents per pound.
