

them ; and such Artifices may be used,  
 and such Clamours raised, by *ill designing*  
*People*, that the present, or some future  
 Administration, may find themselves  
 under the Necessity of removing them,  
 even against the Bent of their own In-  
 clinations ; or they, perhaps, may them-  
 selves voluntarily resign, finding their  
 Salaries by no Means in Proportion to  
 the Dignity of their Office, and the Af-  
 fluence which they have been accustomed  
 to from their Cradles ; and we may be  
 assured, that they would shudder at the  
 Thoughts of making up the Deficiencies,  
 by any clandestine or indirect Methods.  
 Or, as I have already observed, Man's  
 Life is every where precarious, but more  
 so in that Hemisphere. The Damps and  
 vehement Heats of *Florida*, must un-  
 doubtedly be extreamly prejudicial to  
 Northern Constitutions ; but in *Canada*,  
 the human Frame has innumerable Foes  
 to combat with, not only the sudden  
 Vicissitudes
