Trim your prints mercilessly. It is safe to say that three pictures out of every four can be improved by a judicious use of the shears. One picture has too much sky, another too much foreground and another one a whole side with nothing in it worth keeping. When a portion of a picture has nothing in it that is interesting or necessary to the balance of the picture cut it out. Note, if you please, the improvement made by cutting off the foreground in the accompanying illustration. Left untrimmed, as in Fig. 1, the
