In Belgium, under the Act of August, 1920, the expenses necessitated by the payment of the pensions provided in the Act is chargeable as follows:—
 $\frac{5}{8}$ to the State, $\frac{1}{8}$ to the Province, and $\frac{1}{4}$ to the Communes (Municipalities).
 Under such arrangement as between our Federal Government of Canada, the Provinces and the Municipalities, our Federal share would be—
