RULE 6. When two or more members rise at the same time, the Chairman shall decide which of them is in order.

RULE 7. No member shall use any lowd or profane language at these meetings.

RULE 8. An amendment is at all times in order, and if accepted by the mover of the resolution, the question shall be on the motion as amended, if not the amendment shall be the question first under consideration.

RULE 9. Any member offering a Resolution shall reduce the same to writing, if required by the Chairman.

RULE 10. Any member infringing on rules, No.'s 1 and 7, shall pay a fine of 10 cents.

RULE 11. Any member over three months in arrears shall not have a voice at a meeting of this Company.

Any of the By-Laws of this Company may be rescinded or added to, at any regular meeting of this Company, by a two-thirds vote of the Company.
