Carberry, Man., Jan. 8.—The banquet to Sir Charles Tupper and Hugh John Macdonald last night was a most successful affair. Nearly thre hundred people were present. Hugh John Macdonald responded to the toast of the Conservative party of Manitoba, making a lengthy and practical speech on the local situation. He reviewed the course of the Greenway Government, and said that they would be swept from power on the general policy which they had hitherto kept in the background.

Sir Charles gave a brief review of Conservative achievements while in power and challenged any man, as be had challenged Sir Wilfrid Laurier, to give one instance of the Conservatives breaking faith with the public or point to an act which was not in the interests of the country. He dealt vigorously with the course of the Laurier Government, stating that they had wiolated every pledge made, and had made sorry spectacles of themselves before the world. If they had been paid to promote the interests of the Conservative arty they could not do more than had been done to accomplish the object.


Sir Charles in Winnipes.
