Biggest Strike in History of Typographical Unions Imminent.

Pittsburg, Pa., Oct. 3.-The Post to-day says: One of the biggest strikes in the history of the world is now in prospect. It is a concerted move for a working day of nine hours, and will evidently be fought to a finish. Word was received in Pittsburg on Saturday by the local Typographical Union to be ready for the strike in the near future.

WILL A STRIKE REAINT?

Columbus, Ohio, Oct. 3.-Nov. 1 is the day set by the Local Typographical Union for the concerted movement. It is hardly thought that a general strike will result, but in anticipation of the unexpected an assessment of one per cent. is being levied on the printers' earnings as a defence fund.
