Jules Le Rue and Jean Dupre are wizards with sand, producing with remarkable speed wonderful pictures of real worth.

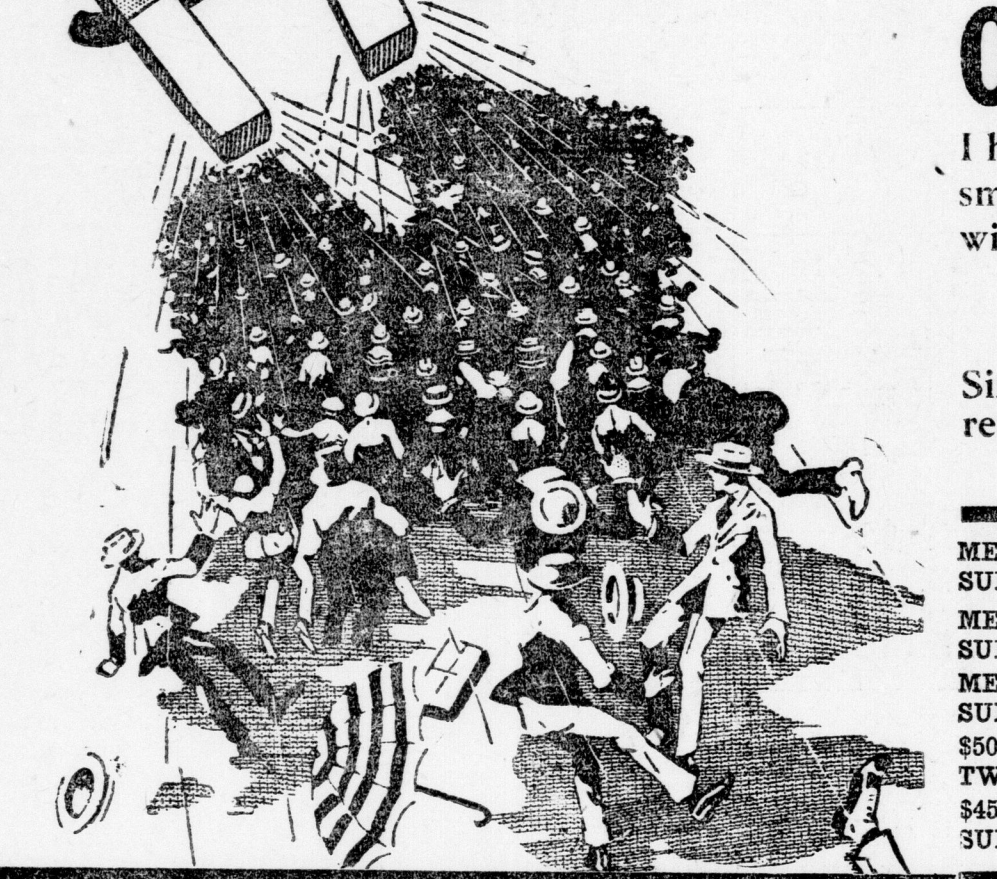
Innes Brothers, two clever young fellows, are a scream from beginning to end, and worthy to be classed with the best comedians who have shown here in years.
