

Even the cat, dog and squirrel give startling evidence of being high-salaried actors, and as for Minnie Ha Ha, the squaw, she alone is worth the price of admission. But it's Mickey that strangles you with laughter and grips you with her hair-raising stunts.

Of the vaudeville it may be said that it alone more than repaid for the price of the best seats. The headliner is McKay's Scottish revue, and it was excellent. The plping, dancing and singing left nothing to be desired, and to the latter rare praise can be given—the accent throughout was that of genuine Scots. One little lassies, who sang "Annie Laurie," was a real treat, with pure notes, clear enunciation and a voice unspoiled by overtraining. Charles Loder and his company in "The Night Doctor" farce are good.


Shelton Brooks, assisted by Horace George, offers a most amusing musical turn of fun and song.
