Moved by Dr. MATHIESON, seconded by MISS HARVEY.

3. That this Meeting recognizes the strong claim which this Society has upon the Public for support, and pledges itself to renewed effort on its behalf.

Moved by the Rev. Mr. RINTOUL, seconded by Mrs. Dorwin.

4. That this Meeting deplores the loss that the Society has sustained on the resignation of their efficient Secretary, Miss Ross, and now tenders unto her, and by the other office bearers of the Society, warmest thanks for their zeal and attention

MRS. DAVIDSON was then proposed, and elected unanimously as First Directress, MRS. GEDDES having resigned.
