REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON SABBATH SCHOOLS.

Your Committee on Sabbath Schools beg leave to report :

We are thankful to the God of all grace for the deep interest in the religious training of the young manifested by the various denominations of Christians in our own and other lands.

It is matter for our sincere gratitude that the Master's loving command, "Feed my lambs," is meeting such hearty obedience.

We cherish the thought, also, that in our branch of the Christian Church good work is being done in behalf of Christ's "little ones." And yet your Committee feel impressed with the importance of more thorough organization, more careful preparation, and more self-denying zeal in this truly great work.

The report of the late General Conference Committee on Sunday-Schools calls attention to two points of importance :

1. The need of fuller statistics from our Sunday-Schools ; and,
2. The importance of holding annual conventions.

Your Committee would respectfully add their hearty endorsement to these two points, and urge more attention to the collection and preparation of the statistics of our Sabbath-Schools ; and that these statistics form a separate report in our Conference minutes.
