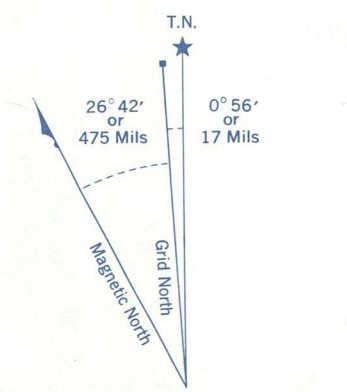
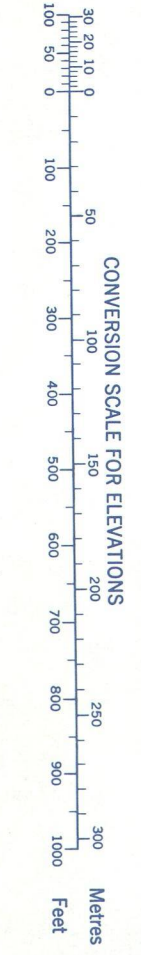

Distance (in metres) of square from this line northward to point	82

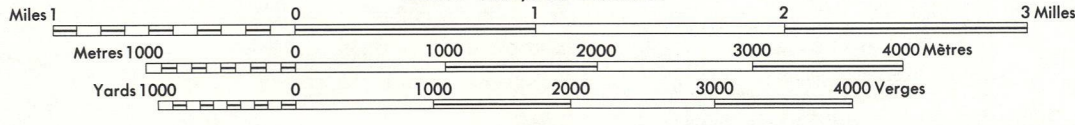
