On motion, the Association suspended business to give place to the Educational Society for a few minutes. Bro. Bill took the Chair. Committee to nominate Officers for the ensuing year, reported. (See Appendix.)

A subscription was then opened to procure funds for the new desks in the Seminary, which soon amounted to nearly Forty Dollars.

Moderator resumed the Chair.

Supplementary report of the Treasurer was submitted, and ordered to be printed.

Moved that the Reports and Resolutions of the Educational Society be printed in the Minutes.

Adjourned. ~
