

Commission, and Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the Office of the United Nations as well as to the Conference on Disarmament and the Secretariat of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) in Geneva. He is a member of the Order of Canada and recipient of the Outstanding Public Service Award.

Canada is actively pressing the EC to stop overfishing in the Northwest Atlantic in waters outside Canada's 200-mile fishing zone. Canada also wants the EC to join with the other members of the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Organization (NAFO) in adopting scientifically-based fishing conservation decisions and quotas for 1990 in the Northwest Atlantic.

The federal government is broadening its diplomatic, political and public information initiatives on the overfishing problem, building on the ongoing efforts of Prime Minister Brian Mulroney, Mr. Clark, Mr. Crosbie, and Mr. Siddon.
