An Act to confer further powers on the Municipal Corporations of Upper Canada.

THEREAS it is desirable to confer on the several Municipal Cor-Preamble. porations in Upper Canada, the powers hereinafter mentioned: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. All travelling expenses heretofore paid or allowed to members of formeral-10 the several Municipal Corporations of Upper Canada, under by-laws or lowances for resolutions passed by such Corporations not exceeding ten cents per mile confirmed. for each mile of travel, are hereby declared valid; and in cases where any excess over the said rate shall have been allowed or paid, such excess shall be repaid to the Corporation entitled thereto by the members of Repayment of 15 such Corporation, within three months after the passing of this Act; excess.

and in default, the members who have received such extra allowance

Provided always, that in the event of any suit or proceeding having Proviso: as to been instituted before the passing of this Act against the members of pending suits 20 any such Corporation to compel repayment of mileage illegally author- for repayment. ized, such suit or proceeding shall be stayed on payment by the said members of the amount of costs incurred in such suit or proceeding, otherwise the suit or proceeding may be prosecuted to an end for the recovery of the costs only.
